Candidate Frequently Asked Questions - Imaging Technologist (CT, IR, Mammo & MRI)

- Q. Who oversees *MTM Staffing, brought to you by Southcoast Physician's Group* ("MTM Staffing")?
 a. You will report to Josh Santos, Director, Radiology Imaging Services at Southcoast Health.
- 2. Q. Who is eligible to apply to become a contracted internal traveler CT, IR, Mammo or MRI Technologist?
 - a. CT, IR, Mammo and MRI Technologists who voluntarily terminated their employment with Southcoast at least 9 months prior to applying to MTM Staffing and CT, IR, Mammo and MRI Technologists who have never worked for Southcoast are eligible to apply. CT, IR, Mammo and MRI Technologists must be in good standing and meet the following licensure/certification requirements:
 - i. <u>For CT Technologist</u>: Successful completion of an accredited program in Radiologic Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology or Radiation Therapy and attainment of primary certification within one year of eligibility and post-primary certification from the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists in Computed Tomography, RT(CT) or Nuclear Medicine Technology Certification Board NMTCB(CT). (Post-primary certification in the advanced practice discipline of CT is required for RT's or CNMT's within one year of eligibility and/or per RT licensure in MA or RI). Current RT licensure in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required.
 - ii. <u>For IR Technologists</u>: Successful completion of an accredited program in Radiologic Technology, and attainment of post-primary certification from the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists in Interventional Radiology RT(VI)/(CI)/or (CV). Current RT licensure in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required. Post-primary certification in Vascular Interventional Radiography and ACLS is preferred.
 - iii. For Mammo Technologist: Successful completion of an accredited program in Radiologic Technology, and attainment of primary certification within one year of eligibility and post-primary certification from the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists in Mammography RT(M). (Postprimary certification in the advanced practice discipline of Mammography is required for RT's within one year of eligibility and/or per RT licensure in MA or RI). Current RT licensure in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is required.
 - iv. For MRI Technologist: Successful completion of an accredited program in Radiologic Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, or Radiation Therapy and attainment of post-primary certification from the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT), American Registry of Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologists (ARMRIT) or the Canadian Association of Medical Radiation Technologists (CAMRT) - OR - the successful completion of an accredited program in Magnetic Resonance Imaging and attainment of primary certification from the ARRT, ARMRIT, or CAMRT.
 - v. <u>For all</u>: Basic Life Support certification is required.
- 3. Q. As an internal traveler CT, IR, Mammo or MRI Technologist, what will I be paid?

- a. \$80 per hour. You will also be eligible to earn overtime at time and one-half when working more than 40 hours in one work week. You will also be eligible for a \$5/hour unrestricted on-call rate when working "on-call" according to Southcoast Health's on-call policy.
- 4. Q. How long is an assignment?
 - a. An assignment is 11, 12 or 13 weeks.
- 5. Q. Can I work more than one assignment?
 - a. At Southcoast's discretion, you may be offered the option to extend for an additional assignment if there is a staffing need. Once you have completed your internal traveler assignment(s), you are encouraged to apply for regular employment, whether part-time or full-time. All vacancies are posted on the Southcoast Career page on the internet.
- 6. Q. How many hours per week will I work?
 - a. Generally, standard workweeks are 40 hours, but we also offer 24 and 32. This could change based on staffing needs.
- 7. Q. Can I work additional shifts to help with coverage if needed?
 - a. Yes. You will be offered opportunities to help with coverage by our Staffing Department based on your skills and the skills needed to safely cover available shifts.
- 8. Q. Where will I work?
 - a. You will have a primary assignment at one of the Radiology Imaging sites and will float as needed to any of our three hospitals, which are all within a maximum 45-minute drive from each other.
- 9. Q. What is the addresses of the Southcoast Hospital where I will be assigned?

- 10. Q. Are employee benefits offered?
 - a. Yes. As an employee of *MTM Staffing, brought to you by Southcoast Physician's Group*, you are eligible for several benefits. You may:
 - i. Elect comprehensive health insurance for yourself, or yourself and your children with shared monthly premium cost (see Benefits Summary for more detail).
 - ii. Participate in the Southcoast Health 403(b) retirement savings plan. If you return as a Southcoast employee with at least two years of previous service to Southcoast, you may be eligible for a company matching contribution of up to 6%.
 - iii. Access Southcoast's in-house Employee Assistance Program, which assists employees with emotional or behavioral concerns, and is offered free to employees and their immediate family members.
- 11. Q. Will I receive a housing stipend?
 - a. No, we are recruiting CT, IR, Mammo and MRI Technologists who reside in our communities.
- 12. Q. How much will I pay to park my car while at work?
 - a. Parking is free for all travelers, employees, patients, and visitors.
- 13. Q. If I am offered a regular status CT, IR, Mammo or MRI Technologist position with Southcoast after serving as a contracted internal traveler CT, IR, Mammo or MRI Technologist, when would my seniority begin?
 - a. Seniority will begin on your first day of work as a regular status employee of Southcoast following your assignment as an internal traveler.
- 14. Q. Who should I contact for additional information?

- a. Additional information is available from your Talent Advisor or from the hiring leader, Josh Santos, Director, Radiology Imaging Services.
- 15. Q. After terminating my temporary employment as a contracted internal traveler, can I apply again in the future?
 - a. You can apply again, but you must wait nine months before you are eligible to be rehired by MTM Staffing as a contracted internal traveler CT, IR, Mammo or MRI Technologist.
